



Recycling carts are picked up every other week. Please place your containers at least three (3) feet apart at the curb.

### **ITEMS TO BE RECYCLED:**

#### NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, OFFICE PAPER



Glossy inserts, catalogs, mail circulars, phone books, paperback books, cereal boxes, envelopes, wrapping paper, etc.

#### CARDBOARD (FLATTENED)



Clean cardboard only. Must be broken down and flattened. Please break down further to ensure it fits in to the cart.

#### GLASS (CLEAR-BROWN-GREEN)



All bottles and jars should be rinsed out. No window glass, lights bulbs, TV tubes, drinking glass.

#### ALUMINUM



Aluminum beverage cans only. Aluminum foil and TV dinner trays are allowed if clean of all food debris.

#### TIN & BI-METAL CANS



Soup, vegetable, juice cans, etc. All cans should be rinsed out.

#### PLASTIC CONTAINERS



This includes plastic bottles with threaded caps and the recycling symbol 1 through 5 and 7. (Look for coding on the bottom of the container.)

### **ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE RECYCLED:**

#### MEDICAL WASTE

No needles, rubber gloves, oxygen tubes, etc.

#### WET PAINT OR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Empty or dry paint cans may be placed in the trash container with the lids removed.
