Public Works and Utilities:

Dan Redman spoke to the board in regards to public works.

Water System: The top of the water tower was repainted due to some rust spots.

Wastewater Treatment Plant: The backup pump has been installed. The bar screen and fabrication is still work in progress. Connor from MCO will no longer be in our area. A new representative from MCO will be next week for training.

Progress Report on Underground Sanitary line from Main St to WWTP: Everything is complete.

Mr. Redman said we are not happy with the restoration. Jeff Hansen of McMahon

Engineering and Jason Guelig of Guelig Construction will be contacted to discuss the matter.

I & I: Manholes are not complete, because it has been too dry for inspections.

North Main Street Bridge Project & Review: Fond du Lac County finished the culvert. Mr.

Redman reported that it looks very nice.

<u>Sewer Lateral Ordinance</u>: Randy Much of MCO will be contacted to find out if he can send us a brief summary of the ordinance to put on our website, newsletter and posted at the village office. A public hearing is being considered for sometime in November.

Streets-Crack filling: The board agreed to hire Fond du Lac County for one day. It will cost

\$250/hour and include two men and all the equipment they need.

Solid Waste and Recycling:

The new contract from Veolia has been signed. Amy Steinke will contact Veolia to find out when residents will receive their new recycling containers and verify when the new recycling schedule will start.

New Business:

Motion: Al Kamenski/Tim Stoppleworth to approve putting 1/8 page ad in Oakfield High School yearbook. Motion carried 7-0.

Budget for 2013:

Budget worksheets were handed out to the committee chairmen. Budget sheets should be turned into the village office before the October 10th board meeting. Amy Steinke discussed the new loan from the Bank of Oakfield which includes a water portion taken out of our existing consolidated loan and also the water, sewer and bridge project from this year.
